As we move through the winter months at the Lodge, we will be updating this page with the conditions of the winter trails: Snowshoe and Cross-country Trails. **We have a dedicated groomer on staff who takes care of the trails on a daily basis.**

Last updated Thursday: January 20, 2022 – 3:00pm

Overall Trail Status: Today we had our groomer break a drive belt. We have located the part and we hope to have it back up and running Friday by midday. We will then re-track the cross country ski trails Friday afternoon. Currently the snowshoe

route is open and the ski trails are open for a powder experience. **All trail users must come inside the main Lodge and sign a waiver at the Outdoor Activity Center (OAC).**

- **Perimeter Loop:** Groomed
- **North Eastern Loop:** Rolled
- **Outer Loop:** Rolled
- **Out There Loop:** Rolled
- **Inner Loop:** Rolled
- **Snowshoe Trail:** Packed

Notes: The winter trails are open to resort guests and the general public. All trail users must sign a waiver inside the conference center which is the winter home for the Outdoor Activity Center. Dogs are allowed on the trails, and must be on leash and cleaned up after.

You can also see the conditions at the Lodge building and on hole 1 of the golf course (with a view of Brockway Mountain) and the current weather conditions from our weather station (located on hole 1).
