**Cabins are OPEN and YEAR-ROUND, [contactless check-in / check-out](#) ([see Lodging policies](#))**

We offer lodging accommodations in Copper Harbor in the form of log cabins. The resort has 24 [cabins](#), made up of 3-bedroom, 2-bedroom, and 1-bedroom units. Cabins either face the golf course (hole #1) or face the forest. Each cabin has a slightly different design, and each cabin has its own private bathroom. There are no lodging rooms in the main building of the Lodge.

We are in the wilderness, and the cabins are rustic and different from one another. The log cabins were [built in the 1930s](#). They do have indoor plumbing (i.e. a bathroom), and we do provide all the necessities for enjoying being in the northwoods of Michigan. Small dogs are welcomed. There is a pet fee. See [Lodging Policies](#) for our full pet policy.

Parties with more than 2 adults in a one bedroom, 4 adults in a two bedroom, or 6 adults in a three bedroom will be subject to a \$25 fee per additional adult.

Discounts are available for military (active and veteran), AARP, and AAA. The discounts are applied when you check-in (not at the time you make your reservations) and present your military, AARP, or AAA id.
