Guests can enjoy history and charm in our cabins. The majority of our cabins are 2-bedroom, with several 3-bedroom and 1-bedroom cabins. Use the form below to check lodging availability and price, and to make a reservation online.

Our cabins include:

- Queen sized beds
- Fireplaces (wood or gas, depending on the cabin)
- Heat base-board and/or forced air (depending on the cabin)
- Outside grills (use charcoal only)

- Pet friendly accommodations (see <u>pet policy</u>)
- Mini-fridges
- Microwaves
- Water kettles (for hot water and tea) and coffee makers (for coffee), with <u>Keweenaw Coffee Works</u> coffee and <u>Fraser</u> <u>Tea</u> provided.
- and more.

There is a story behind the coffee that we have in the cabins from Keweenaw Coffee Works (<u>learn more about the KML special blend</u>), as we intentionally select our coffee suppliers.

*All cabins have at least one bathroom in them. All bathrooms have a shower, with most of them having a shower/tub combination.

We require a minimum-night stays: 2-nights (find out why).

We do not have cable TVs (<u>find out why</u>), kitchens, or hotel phones in our cabins.

The mattresses in the cabins are circa 2014. The couches and seats are circa 2005, so they are dated, but authentic.

If you want to be connected to the outside world while you are at the resort, we do have Internet connection at the resort. However, realize, we are not in downtown Chicago, but in the

wilderness as far north as you can go in Michigan. Thus the Internet speeds are not fiber speeds. You can connect to the Internet through our WiFi network, which has been setup throughout the Lodge building and the network of cabins. WiFi tends to be stronger the closer you are to the Lodge building. So if you are staying in a cabin further away from the Lodge building, the WiFi signal might be



lower, and thus Internet connection slower. [learn more]

In addition, we have a <u>Rivian Waypoint electric vehicle charger</u> (<u>Level 2 charger</u>). It is located next to the Lodge building. And Cabin 12 has a Rivian Level 1 EV charger on its front porch for guests who are staying in the cabin to use to charge their electric vehicle overnight. [<u>learn more</u>]

List of Cabins

Below is a list of the cabins based upon the number of bedrooms. By clicking on the individual cabins you can see the outside and inside pictures of each respective cabin, along with the cabin layout. Cabins have wood-burning fireplaces unless indicated. The cabins were built in 1934 and 1935, except for cabins 6 and 22 (cabin 6 burned down and was rebuilt in a different style in the 1980s and 1990s; cabin 22 was built from

scratch during that time as well).

Note: During the **summer**, all the cabins are open. During the **winter**, only the golf course-side cabins are open (cabins 1-14, make a winter reservation).

If you are renting a cabin with an outside grill, look into <u>our</u> <u>Grilling Kits</u>.

If you are thinking about bringing a pet, make sure you are renting one of the cabins that we allow dogs (i.e. pet friendly), and understand the <u>pet policy</u>. Eight (8) of our cabins are pet-friendly.

3-bedroom, 1-bathroom cabins (up to 6 people can stay in the cabin)

- <u>Cabin 1</u> (gas fireplace, forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill
- <u>Cabin 21</u> (gas fireplace, base-board heat) outside grill, pet friendly

2-bedroom, 2-bathroom cabins (up to 4 people can stay in the cabin)

- <u>Cabin 4</u> (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill
- <u>Cabin 5</u> (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill
- <u>Cabin 7</u> (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill (shared with cabin 6), pet friendly
- <u>Cabin 17</u> (base-board heat) outside grill, pet friendly
- <u>Cabin 18</u> (base-board heat) outside grill
- <u>Cabin 23</u> (base-board heat) outside grill
- <u>Cabin 24</u> (base-board heat) outside double grill (shared with cabin 25)
- <u>Cabin 25</u> (base-board heat) outside double grill (shared with cabin 24)

2-bedroom, 1-bathroom cabins (up to 4 people can stay in the cabin)

- <u>Cabin 3</u> (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill,
 pet friendly
- Cabin 10 (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill
- <u>Cabin 11</u> (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill
- Cabin 12 (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill
- <u>Cabin 14</u> (forced-air and base-board heat) outside grill,
 pet friendly
- Cabin 15 (base-board heat)— outside grill, pet friendly
- <u>Cabin 16</u> (base-board heat) outside grill [note: fireplace is currently not available], pet friendly
- <u>Cabin 19</u> (base-board heat) outside grill
- Cabin 20 (base-board heat) outside grill

1-bedroom, 1-bathroom cabins (up to 2 people can stay in the cabin)

- <u>Cabin 2</u> Honeymoon Suite, with a hot tub, single structure, forced-air and base-board heat, outside grill
- <u>Cabin 6 A&B</u> duplex, handicap accessible, forced-air and base-board heat, outside grill (shared with cabin 7)
- <u>Cabin 8 A&B</u> duplex, gas fireplace, forced-air and baseboard heat, outside grill (shared with cabin 9), pet friendly
- <u>Cabin 9 A&B</u> duplex, gas fireplace, forced-air and baseboard heat, outside grill (shared with cabin 8)

The 1-bedroom cabins are duplexes, with 2 units in each cabin structure.
