Hi John,

The 7-pin devices themselves are easy enough to install on your own provided you have safe access to the top of your fixtures. If I recall correctly, you mentioned that you have a bucket on-site. This should be enough to do the job as the 7-pins should just be a twist on/off the top of your fixture. When it comes to the controller and signal booster, however, there may be more electrical work involved that should be done by a contractor.

Whichever contractor you prefer can do this work for you; they would just have to order the parts through our distributor: Standard Electric – Sault St Marie.

Unfortunately, with the final quote, I am unable to break the pricing out individually. This quote provides the full package that we have discussed and broken down over time.
